– MINI FIRST AID –

Following on from the success of last year's sessions, we have booked 'Mini First Aid North London' to visit us next week to deliver First Aid training to all the children.
Reception and Key Stage 1 will learn about what happens to their bodies if they are hurt and how they might be treated by an adult. Years 3 – 6 will learn how to deal with bumps, burns, breaks and bleeding, carry out CPR and deal with choking. This will continue to build on the skills the children learnt last year.

the police immediately on 999.


