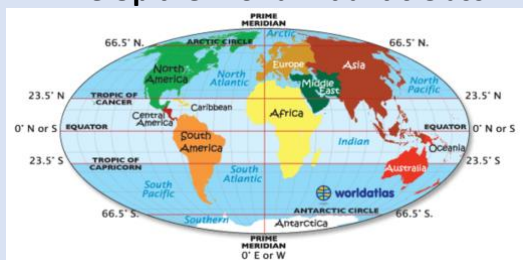


What are we learning this half term?

Children will explore the concept of evolution. We will explore the process by which plants and mammals develop and change, over time.
