






# Apple Blossom class Home Learning Project

Make sure it includes your name, where you live and your job. And of course, don't forget to draw a picture of yourself.</p>	<p>Discuss with a friend or family member about Anglo-Saxon life. Find out what jobs they might have done? What did they eat? What did they wear?</p>	<p>Make an Anglo-Saxon Boat out of recyclable materials! You can use your own creation or look on the internet for ideas.</p> 	<p>Teach adults at home how to make a cloth by weaving. As the Anglo-Saxons had to clothe themselves with what they could get hold of, they used wool. The wool was warm and waterproof.
