





Bounce: t-t-t-tower Handwrite: Down the tower, across the tower




Bounce: c-c-c-caterpillar Handwrite: Curl around the caterpillar

Bounce: p-p-p-pirate Handwrite: Down the plait and over the pirate's face


Stretch: nnnnnnet Handwrite: Down Nobby, over his net



Bounce: 0-0-0-orange Handwrite: All around the orange








Stretch: Illlleg Handwrite: Down the long leg

Bounce: e-e-e-egg Handwrite: Lift off the top and scoop out the egg






















Stretch: ffffflower Handwrite: Down the stem, and draw the leaves












Bounce: b-b-b-boot Handwrite: Down the laces to the heel, round the toe

Bounce: u-u-u-u-umbrella Handwrite: Down and under, up to the top and draw the puddle










Bounce: w-w-w-worm Handwrite: Down, up, down, up

Bounce: y-y-y-y-yak Handwrite: Down a horn yp a horn and under his head






























