<p><b>Writing</b></p>	<p><b>Learning Focus</b> – Making predictions about the story 'Lost and Found'</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> Use the front cover of the book to help you predict what the story might be about.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> In your home learning book or in google classroom draw and write what you think this book might be about by looking at the front cover.</p> <p><b>Review –</b> Did I use the pictures and the words on the cover to help me make my predictions?</p>	<p><b>Learning Focus</b> - Listening carefully to a story Lost and Found'</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> 1)Listen carefully to the story. 2)Now listen to the story again to check you have understood it. 3) Decide which is your favourite part.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> In your home learning book or in google classroom draw and write about your favourite part of the story.</p> <p><b>Review –</b> Did I use my phonic knowledge to help me write words and sentences?</p>	<p><b>Learning Focus</b> - Writing a list of things I would need to take to the South Pole</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> 1) Read the document 'How to Make a List'.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> In your home learning book or in google classroom write a list of things you would need to pack if you were going to the South Pole.</p> <p><b>Review –</b> Have I included useful things on my list? Have I numbered each item? Have I written one item on each</p>	<p><b>Learning Focus</b> – Using adjectives to describe your friend</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> Read and understand the describing words on the word mat.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> In your home learning book or in google classroom draw a picture of your friend and use the describing word mat to help you describe them.</p> <p><b>Review -</b> Did I use the word mat to check the meaning of the words before using them in my writing?</p>	<p>Write a detailed description of one of the characters in your book.</p> <p>Make a prediction about the storyline.</p>

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<b>Topic</b>	<p><b>Geography/History Learning Focus –</b> To show how trains have changed over time.</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> Look at the ‘History of trains’ powerpoint pictures and read the captions with help if you need.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> Look at the pictures of trains on and sort trains from oldest to newest on the timeline. (Click and drag to sort the pictures or number the pictures in your home learning book or google classroom.)</p> <p><b>Review –</b> Check the answers. How well did I do?</p>	<p><b>Science Learning Focus -</b> Follow a method and perform a simple test to create a rainbow. I can observe closely and record what I see.</p> <p><b>Learn –</b> Set up your experiment after listening carefully to the method in the recording.</p> <p><b>Practise –</b> Become a scientist and carry out the experiment, following each step carefully.</p> <p><b>Review –</b> What happened? Ask a grownup to take a photograph of what you see during your rainbow experiment or draw a picture of your findings. Read the ‘Where did the rainbow come from.’</p>	<p><b>Computing/Music/Other Learning Focus -</b> <b>Learn –</b> 1. Watch the music video- week 1 ‘Start The Day With Exercise’ - <a href="https://www.outoftheark.co.uk/ootam-at-home/">https://www.outoftheark.co.uk/ootam-at-home/</a></p> <p><b>Practise –</b> 1. Think of some actions you could do to accompany each verse of this song. For example:- • Stretch arms in a rainbow motion • Knees up high • Jog on the spot</p> <p><b>Review –</b> 1. Did you enjoy the song? 2.
