## We Love The NHS

Sending a heartfelt thank you from the children to the NHS. To show our appreciation for all their hard and sometimes dangerous work, Bowes Primary School will be sending our local hospital our love...literally...in the form of a big, rainbow striped heart. To do this we need your help!

The heart will be made up of photos of all the children sending their special thank you messages to the hospital staff. So very soon we will be asking you to send a photo of your child saying thank you. This could be a photo of them holding up a thank you note, or maybe a photo of a drawing or a model, like Lego bricks spelling out 'Thank you'. It is entirely up to you.

Each class will be assigned a colour of the rainbow, so the only thing we ask, is that the colour you have been assigned is dominant in your photo. It could be the background colour, or the colour of the clothes your child is wearing, or the colour of the Lego bricks...that way, when we put the photos together they will make our lovely rainbow.
