The theme for the week this year is 'Make A Noise About Bullying' and classes will be working on ways to prevent bullying and what to do if it is happening.

KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE

Anti-Bullying week is next week and at Bowes, we are here to help make sure that no child experiences harm from bullying. The <u>Anti-Bullying Alliance</u> offers advice for parents, including information and tools to help you take the right action.



Bullying is: Intentional: It is on purpose (hurtful behaviour). Repeated: The behaviour happens more than once. Harmful: It hurts the body and/or feelings. Bullying is not when two people have a disagreement or fall out over something, it is usually <u>Several Times On Purpose (STOP!</u>)

Children should be encouraged to talk about bullying and keeping safe and be advised to get help from an adult if they are feeling unsafe or worried.
