KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE

What is Early Help?

Every family can go through challenging times at some point. Early Help means working with you and your family, so that small problems don't become big problems. Early Help is for everybody, for families with young children and young people of any age.

Why would I want Early Help?

There are lots of reasons why people look for Early Help. It could be that you are worried about your child's health, development or behaviour. It may be that you are worried about money or housing and how that is affecting your family. Maybe your family is affected by domestic abuse, drugs, alcohol or crime. Perhaps your child is a carer for other people, or maybe you have had a bereavement in the family that has made life a challenge. Early Help can give you the tools to solve any challenges or problems you are experiencing with help from others where needed.

How can I get Early Help?

If you feel you and your family need support to solve some problems, you can contact the Bowes Designated Safeguarding Leads who will be able to refer you to Enfield Early Help. You can also self-refer for Early Help via the <u>Enfield Early Help</u> <u>Family Hub</u> or by calling 020 8379 2002.


